The 2019 conference was such a worthwhile investment in our professional development! There was a wealth of input from across sectors committed to health, safety and wellbeing.

One of the many sessions I found beneficial was a review of the Westgate Bridge disaster in 1970, through the lens of Michael Quinlan's "*Ten Pathways to Death and Disaster: Learning from Fatal Incidents in Mines and Other High Hazard Workplaces*"<sup>1</sup>.

Those of us with responsibilities for our work health and safety systems should pause to reflect on the "ten pathways";

1. engineering, design and maintenance flaws
2. failure to heed warning signs
3. flaws in risk assessment
4. flaws in management systems
5. flaws in auditing
6. economic/reward pressures
7. failures in regulatory oversight
8. worker or supervisor concerns ignored
9. poor workplace communication and trust
10. deficiencies in emergency and rescue procedures
